

New Membership Categories

The Board of Directors has approved the following new categories of Membership within The Royal College of Dentists of Canada. These have been integrated in the DRAFT Bylaw Number 2024 09 28 and are provided below for informational purposes.

- “Life-Active Fellow” means a Fellow, or Charter Fellow who has met the conditions for Life-Active Fellowship in the Corporation as determined by the Board and has been approved to pay 50% of the annual membership dues by the Board. Any Life-Active Fellow are considered a Voting “RCDC member” and are able to use the FRCDC designation. They will also be eligible to be a Fellowship Examiner or Committee member if called;
- “Retired Fellow” means a Fellow, or Charter Fellow who has met the conditions for Retired Fellowship in the Corporation as determined by the Board and has been exempt from paying membership dues by the Board. Any Retired Fellow is considered a Non-Voting “RCDC member”, is able to use the FRCDC designation, and be eligible to be a Fellowship Examiner or Committee member if called; This membership category includes those that currently hold the status of “Life Fellow”.
- “Life-Active Member” means a Member who has met the conditions for Life-Active Membership in the Corporation as determined by the Board and has been approved to pay 50% of the annual membership dues by the Board. Any Life-Active Member are considered a Non-Voting “RCDC member” and is able to use the MRCDC designation. They will also be eligible to be a Committee member if called;
- “Retired Member” means a Member who has met the conditions for Retired Life Membership in the Corporation as determined by the Board and has been exempt from paying membership dues by the Board. Any Retired Member is considered a Non-Voting “RCDC member”, is able to use the MRCDC designation and will be eligible to be a Committee member if called; This membership category includes those that currently hold the status of “Life Member”.
